WATERCOLOR FACETED FISH





MATERIALS

MB1573 Fish Facetini
Medium Brush
Small Brush
Detail Brush
Sanding Stick or Scraping Tool

COLORS

CMM 2 - Stonewashed
CMM 48 - Guacamole
CMM 85 - Oceanscape
CMM 62 - Just Blue
CMM 11 - Blue Lagoon
CMM 67 - Snowflake
CMM 46 - Sunnyside Up
CMM 69 - Carrot Juice
CMM 98 - Red Head



INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. If you're doing the blue-green fish, thin down Guacamole, Oceanscape, and Blue Lagoon paint with 50% water to 50% paint.
- 2. If you're going the yellow-orange fish, thin down Sunnyside Up, Carrot Juice, and Red Head paint with 50% water to 50% paint.
- 3. Use a medium brush to apply 2–3 coats of the watered-down paint to the top half of the body:
 - a. Blue Fish Oceanscape
 - b. Yellow Fish Sunnyside Up
- 4. Next, use a medium brush to apply 2-3 coats of watered-down paint to the top fin and the bottom half of the body:
 - a. Blue Fish Blue Lagoon
 - b. Yellow Fish Carrot Juice and Sunnyside Up
- 5. Use a small brush to apply 2-3 coats of watered-down paint to the side fins:
 - a. Blue Fish Guacamole
 - b. Yellow Fish Red Head
- 6. Use a small brush to apply 2-3 coats of watered-down paint to the tail fin:
 - a. Blue Fish Guacamole and Oceanscape
 - b. Yellow Fish Red Head
- 7. Use a detail brush to apply 2 coats of Snowflake to the eyes.
- 8. When the fish is dry, us a sanding stick or a scraping tool to remove the paint that is on the raised lines of the piece.
- 9. Finally, use a detail brush to apply 2 coats of Stonewashed to the pupils.

TIPS

- Because we watered down the paint, we aren't going for solid coverage. We want it to be a watercolor effect.
- The sanding stick works best when the paint is dry, so allow it to sit for a few minutes.
